(A celebration of Dance & Music; Food; Costume & Jewellery)

Day & Date	:	Friday, 2 nd August 2019
Venue	:	Doon Public School
Theme	:	A celebration of Dance & Music; Food ; Costume & Jewellery of the chosen country
Number of Participants	:	6-10 (2 student Chefs, 2 for Costume & Jewellery-one boy, one girl; rest can be for Dance & music)
Eligibility Criteria		
(Dance & Music)	:	Classes 7, 8
(Food)	:	Classes 9, 10
(Costumes & Jewellery)	:	Class 6

Around the World in One Day Competition serves as a platform for students and teachers to research, explore and analyse peoples' lifestyles in the other countries.

The assessment would be based on the performance in Dance & Music, Food and Costumes & Jewellery. The three best countries chosen on the basis of the above criteria will be awarded.

Rules and Regulations:

1. The participants will be allotted a Registration Number as their identity for the competition.
2. Only two teachers are allowed to accompany the participants. The teachers will be required to stay in the school till the event ends. Teachers will not be allowed to assist their students.
3. All team members must be from the same school.
4. List of the countries will be uploaded on the Google registration form. The link to access the same is <https://docs.google.com/forms/d/e/1FAIpQLScnfivX61614YRWo3xDyI5hQ6ko-XzI7bljnFcBWgiHdRSpQw/viewform>.
5. The choice of country will be on **FIRST COME FIRST SERVE BASIS**. Once a country is chosen it will be off the list for the other participating schools (**Please note: Once the country is selected, it cannot be changed**).
6. **Dance & Music :**
 - The participants are requested to bring their own Pen Drive which should be submitted to the co-ordinator of the event.
 - Participants can carry their own props but they should not be heavy.
 - Participants are required to perform in authentic costumes of the chosen country.
 - Performance should be confined to stage only.
 - Duration for this part of the event is **3 minutes** only.
7. **Food :**
 - The two participants should bring the ingredients to prepare food without fire.
 - The participant team has to prepare **'One Main Course Dish', 'One Smoothie/Mocktail' and 'One Dessert Dish'** (Food should be of the chosen country).
 - Only One electric connection will be provided by the Host School.
 - The participants must bring all the required equipment and kitchen utensils (like cutting board, knives, pans, bowls, etc) as well as any other material needed to cook and serve.
 - Participant team is allowed to bring semi cooked food.
 - It is imperative for each team to return the working area in a spotless condition.
 - Use of alcohol is strictly prohibited.
 - The duration for this part of the event is **1 hour only**.
 - Disposable plates, spoon, fork, tissues and glasses should be brought for serving the

8. **Traditional Costume & Jewellery:** The participants (one girl & one boy) will come in their requisite costume and jewellery.
- Please note that the costumes should be decent and traditional.
 - The participants have to walk the ramp in the selected costumes along with the background music of the selected country.
 - The duration for the ramp walk is **1 minute**.
 - The background music should be submitted to the coordinator of the event in a pen drive.
9. If any one of the said rules is violated, the team will be disqualified.
10. The decision of the jury would be final and binding.

Judgement will be based on these criteria:

- **Dance & Music:** Choreography, Costume, Expression, Synchronisation, Overall Performance
- **Food:** Taste, Presentation, Creativity and Authentic Flavour.
- **Traditional Costumes & Jewellery:** Confidence, Presentation, Choice of the Music and Ethnicity.

Prizes:

- Certificates of participation will be awarded to all the participants.
